The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has just published the Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) Proposed Rule for 2010. CMS addresses such topics as composite APCs, pharmacy overhead, biologicals used as devices, drug administration, partial hospitalization, physician supervision, Kidney Disease Education, Pulmonary Rehabilitation, Cardiac Rehabilitation, and Intensive Cardiac Rehabilitation. In addition, the Proposed Rule addresses quality reporting and outpatient hospital acquired conditions. All OPPS topics presented by CMS will be reviewed.

Each participant will receive a comprehensive manual that outlines the proposed rule for 2010 and an itemized table that shows all the changes for each CPT/HCPCS code between 2009 and 2010. This program is especially designed for reimbursement, health information management, revenue cycle, billing, and regulatory professionals.

Bob Masters, nationally recognized as an expert in Medicare billing, and frequent CHA speaker will present the program.

At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

- Understand the implications of proposed billing changes under OPPS for 2010.
- Evaluate potential changes in reimbursement.
